I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the 133<sup>rd</sup> Regular Session on "Land Policy for Sustainable Rural Development" is scheduled to be held at the International Centre for Land Policy Studies and Training (ICLPST), Taiwan, R.O. China, during 19 May – 16 June 2017. The programme is designed for the training of senior officers/educators in land settlements, land reforms, cooperatives, agricultural development, agricultural extension and supporting services and rural development planning. The programme is based on the following objective:

- To provide the participants with understanding of the most recent lessons learned in achieving goals for effective rural land administration, where policy is dominated by rapid urban growth, work trade agreements and competition over natural resources;
- To introduce the participants to the techniques of information management and institutional development that integrate rural populations into the overall national economic, political and social development;
- To give a deeper knowledge of institutional and administrative means for effective management of natural resources endowments, and land/resource tenure systems as a national functional framework.
- To prepare a framework for meeting national development goals; and
- To equip the participants with skills and perspectives in assessment and modeling agricultural land information appraisal, broad knowledge and applicability of land information systems (LIS) and geographic information systems (GIS) in developing or transition country situations;

The programme is aimed at exploring, with participants, the models, policy development and policy implementation regarding property ownership and land tenure dynamics, developing land information system, rural economy and development, managing local governance for sustainable development and land policy experience of Taiwan.

**Essential Qualifications:**

Nominee must satisfy the following:

- ✓ Hold a bachelor's degree in land policy and administration, rural development, agricultural economics, rural sociology, agrarian reform, town planning and any other relevant qualification.
- ✓ Be presently working as an administrator, planner or policy maker in the field of agricultural development and policy;
- ✓ Be proficient in both spoken and written English language to enable him/her to follow the lectures and instructions, which are given in English only;
- ✓ Be below 55 years of age; and
- ✓ Be medically certified to be fit for study and travel abroad

Nominees will avail themselves of the following:

**Entitlements:**

- a) Both way air travel from the capital city of nominee to Taipei and back on economy class, shortest possible route;
- b) Board and lodging expenses at the training institute;
- c) Books and literature, tuition fee; and
- d) Travel within R.O. China in connection with the training including field visits.

No other expenses or expenses incurred during the period of journey, passport/visa charges, airport tax etc., are covered under the training fellowship. No-out of-pocket allowance is admissible. Nominating country government may provide sufficient funds to its nominees to meet the expenses other than those covered under the fellowship.

Excellency may kindly consider nominating the prospective candidate to the training course on " Land Policy for Sustainable Rural Development". The prospective nominee is required to submit their application ONLINE through the link: <http://aardo.org/aardohomepage/formDD.php>. The deadline for receiving the nomination form by AARDO is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017. Preference will be given to the candidates from countries that are regularly paying their membership contribution. Selection of candidates will be made in consultation with the host Government/Training Institute, keeping in view of the availability of training slots and the response from the member countries.
